

Delicious Handout for Workshop

If you are using delicious on your home or classroom computer you need to install the buttons in the browser before you can “tag” site the way we did in the workshop.

Here is the site:

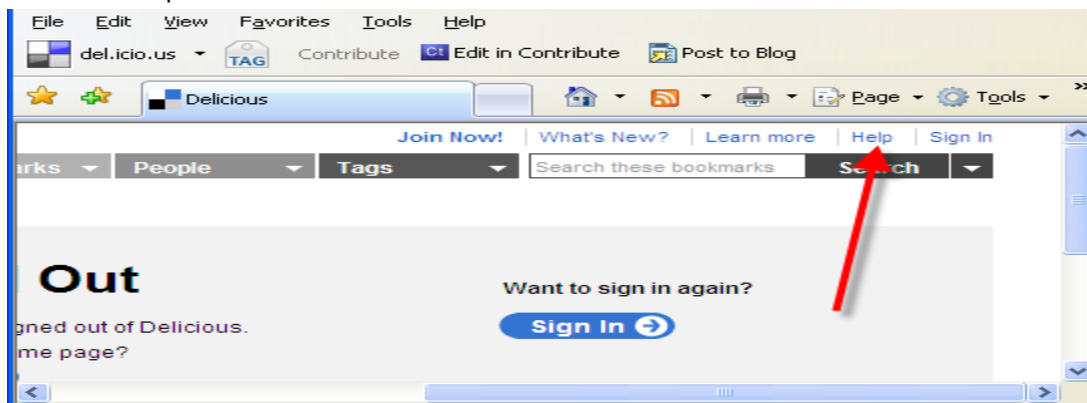

You need to login to your delicious account. Notice there is an option for leaving you logged in. This is great for ease in saving bookmarks but not a good idea on a common computer (such as a lab computer or media center computer).

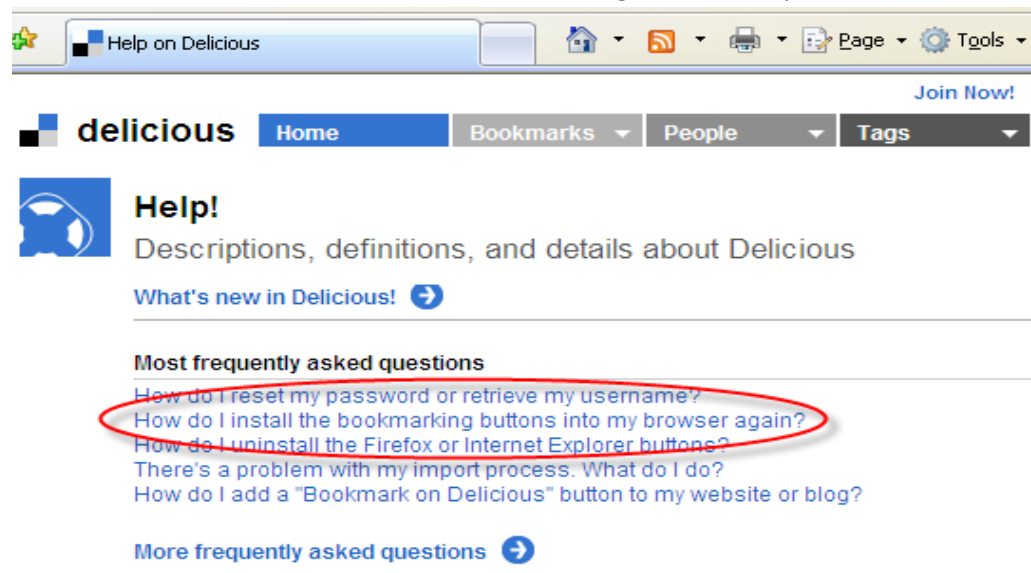

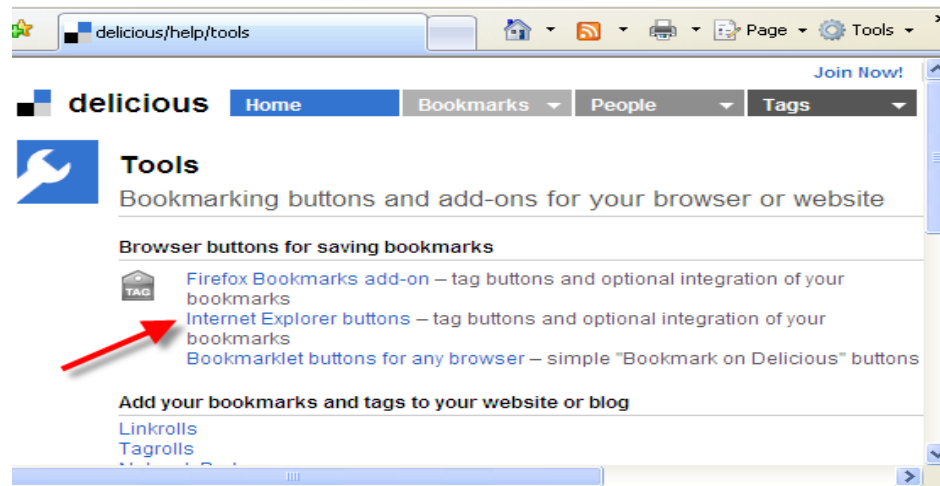
Go to the Help link:



Then look for the “How do I install the bookmarking buttons...” option:

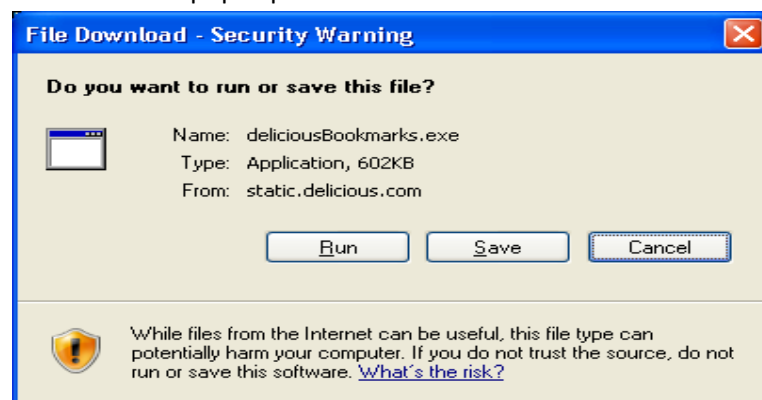


If you have Internet Explorer (which your school computers do) select the Internet Explorer buttons

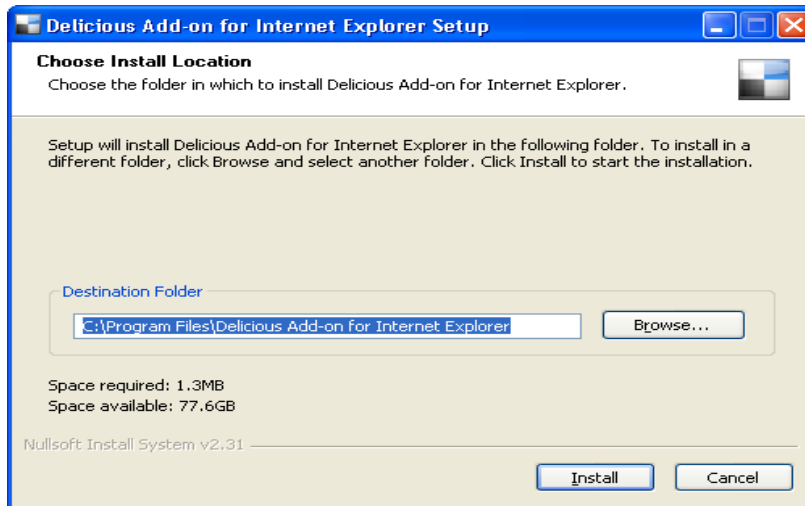


Select “Install Internet Explorer Ad-on” and then “Add Buttons”.

When this box pops up select “Run”

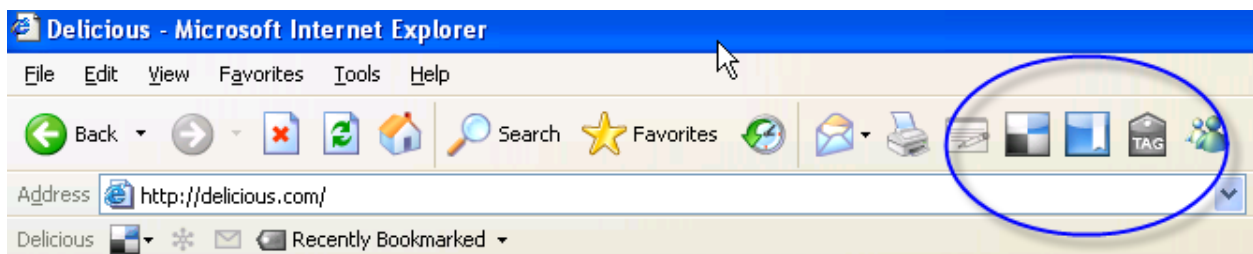


Then “Run” at the next box. And then “Install” at the following box:



Once you install the buttons you will be prompted to close your browser. This is so the buttons can be installed. You must close all browser windows to proceed.

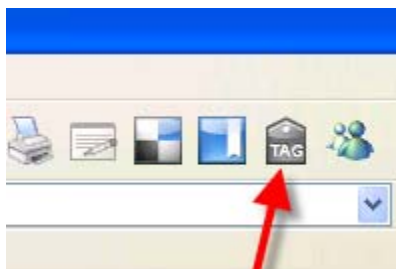
When the installation is complete the browser will launch with new buttons.



Step 3 will ask you to import bookmarks. You may choose to skip this step if you have already done this.

Now you will be able to “tag” any site you choose to add to your delicious account.

Once you find a site you’d like to tag find the tag button on the top right-hand section of your browser:



Click TAG button and the “Save a Bookmark” box will popup. At the least you will want to “tag” the site so that it will be easier to access later. See guide below:
